These Terms and Conditions ("Tool Terms") govern access to and use of the Globe-America Compliance Tool Suite, including all free and paid online tools available at globe-america.com and related subdomains ("Tools"). By accessing or using any Tool, you agree to these Tool Terms in addition to the Globe-America Terms of Service.

1. Description of Tools

The Globe-America Compliance Tool Suite includes browser-based tools designed to assist defense contractors with CMMC compliance self-assessment, documentation preparation, evidence management, and readiness planning. Tools are organized across four access tiers:

- **Free / Prospect Tools:** C3 Compliance Kit (C3 Kit), CMMC ROI Calculator, Assessment Defense Checklist, Subcontractor Readiness Scorecard. No access code required.
 - **Paid Prospect Tools:** Level 1 Self-Assessment Tool (\$497). Access code provided upon purchase.
 - **Tier 3 (Bronze) Tools:** SPRS Score Calculator, POA&M; Builder, Compliance Roadmap Builder, SSP Scope & Intake Tool, Core Policy Set Generator, POA&M; Closeout Tracker.
 - **Tier 2 (Silver) Tools:** Contract Compliance Decoder, CUI Scoping Wizard, Policy Gap Checker, Evidence Tracker, RACI Builder, Procedure Builder.
 - **Tier 1 (Gold) Tools:** Executive Compliance Dashboard, Defense Mock Assessment, SSP Builder Assistant, and all lower-tier tools.

2. Access Codes and Licensing

- Access codes are issued to the purchasing organization and are non-transferable.
 - Access codes may not be shared with parties outside the purchasing organization.
 - Globe-America reserves the right to revoke access codes issued in violation of these terms.
 - Client-tier access codes are provided by your Globe-America advisor upon engagement initiation.
 - The Level 1 Self-Assessment client access code is subject to rotation on January 1 and July 1 of each year. Updated codes are provided to active clients.

3. Permitted Use

Tools may be used only for the following purposes:

- Internal compliance assessment and preparation activities within the purchasing organization
- Preparation of compliance documentation for your organization's own DoD contracts and subcontracts
- Educational and planning purposes related to CMMC compliance

The following uses are expressly prohibited:

- Resale, sublicensing, or redistribution of Tool access codes or outputs
 - Use of Tools to provide compliance consulting services to third parties without a written reseller or partner agreement with Globe-America
 - Reverse engineering, decompiling, or reproducing Tool functionality
 - Using Tool outputs as official compliance certifications or attestations submitted to the DoD without completing the required formal assessment process

4. Nature of Tool Outputs

Tool outputs, including SPRS score calculations, gap analyses, SSP drafts, policy templates, and compliance roadmaps, are informational and preparatory in nature. They do not constitute:

- A formal CMMC assessment conducted by a C3PAO or Certified CMMC Assessor (CCA)
 - An official SPRS submission. Scores must be submitted by the Affirming Official through the official DoD PIEE portal (piee.eb.mil)
 - Legal advice or a legal compliance determination
 - A guarantee or warranty of CMMC certification readiness

5. Data and Privacy

The Globe-America Compliance Tool Suite is designed to minimize data exposure. Most Tools operate using client-side processing in the user's browser. Data entered into Tools is not transmitted to Globe-America servers unless explicitly indicated (e.g., intake form submissions). Users should not enter Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) into any online tool. Data governance for CUI is the responsibility of the using organization.

6. Intellectual Property in Tool Outputs

Tool outputs generated through user-provided inputs (completed assessments, populated SSP sections, generated policy documents) belong to the user organization. The underlying Tool frameworks, templates, scoring methodologies, and the G.A.R.D.™ Framework remain the intellectual property of Globe-America Consulting, Inc..
